the largest on the island and the fourth largest in the country.

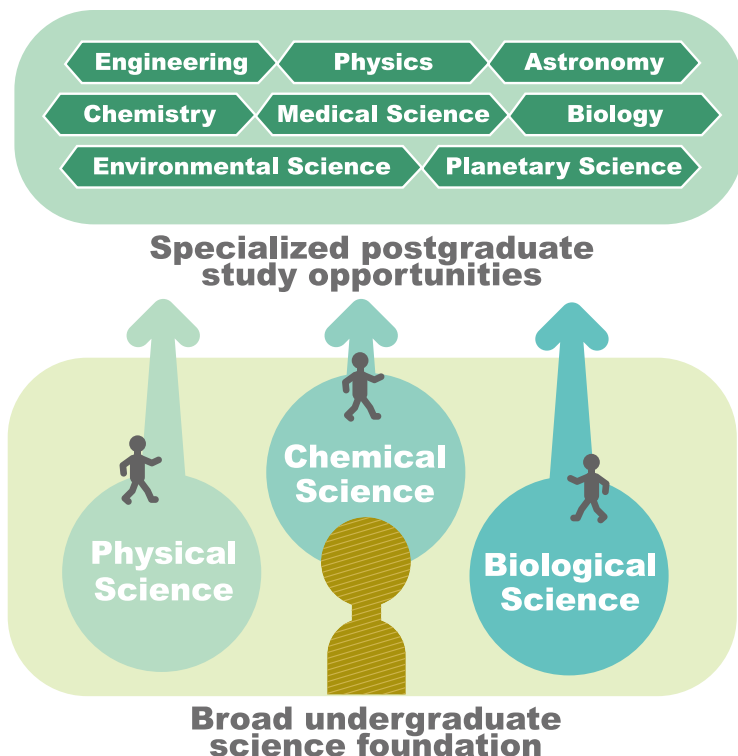
# Course details

- Financial support and scholarship opportunities.



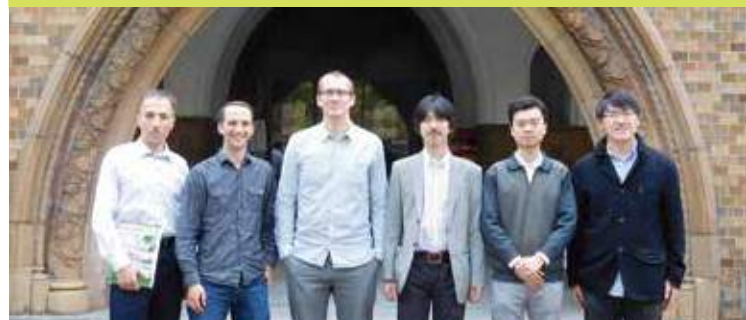
## Three core sciences, multiple options for specialization
